If you need information on a purebred dog, please call us (at the number above) or HART (number contained on attached pages) with the breed type and request the breed rescue number.

The Brittany Foundation is NOT a shelter at this time. We CANNOT take dogs in. We CAN, however, help you in other ways. If you need assistance in placing a dog (whether it's your own or a rescue) we can provide you guidelines on placing the dog in the best possible home. We offer a 12-page document containing information on how to place a dog on your own. It includes an adoption application and an adoption agreement which is a binding contract between you and the home where you place the dog. Please let us know if you wish this document sent to you either via fax or mail.

Please also refer to the LA Times Classified Pet Adoption Section or The Pet Press for other rescue organizations including those who have shelters or do adoption programs. [Please note: Although we run an adoption program, we currently have a 3 month waiting period because there are so many people who want to show their dogs with us. We suggest your try other rescue groups who run adoption programs or request our document. If you are willing to wait & are not in a desperate situation, please ask to be put on our waiting list. Thank you.]

As you know, **IF YOU TAKE YOUR OWN ANIMAL TO THE ANIMAL SHELTER, IT WILL BE KILLED WITHIN 24 HOURS.** A rescued animal has between 3 and 7 days for an owner to retrieve it before it becomes available for adoption. Then, depending on the shelter's assessment of adoptability, the animal may have anywhere from 1 to 4 days before it is killed.

Please take responsibility for this animal. Their fate is
in YOUR hands.
